	HJ Res 55	Abercrombie (D-HI) & Jones (R-NC)	Vehicle for a discharge petition, to force a real and open debate of the war onto the floor of the House. Once the debate begins, the content of any other bill can be offered as an amendment.	
	H.J.Res. 73	Murtha (D-PA)	The re-deployment of United States forces in Iraq, by direction of Congress, is hereby terminated and the forces involved are to be redeployed at the earliest practicable date.	
	H.R. 4232	McGovern (D-MA)	Stop funding the deployment of U.S. Armed Forces in Iraq. Provides for the safe and orderly withdrawal of all troops; Supports internationalizing force presence. Would not prohibit or restrict non-defense funding to carry out reconstruction in Iraq.	
	H. Con. Res. 197	Lee (D-CA)	Declaring that it is the policy of the United States not to enter into any base agreement with the Government of Iraq that would lead to a permanent United States military presence in Iraq.	
	H.Con. Res.321	Kucinich (D-OH) & Paul (R-TX)	Providing that the new permanent Council of Representatives of Iraq is encouraged to debate and vote on whether or not a continued United States military presence in Iraq is desired by the Government of Iraq.	
	H.R. 3142	Allen (D-ME)	Iraq Sovereignty Promotion Act, No Long term designs on Iraq. Bottom Line: Occupation of Iraq recruits enemies not allies and starves real security and social benefits. Get out!

	H.Res.635	Conyers (D-MI)	Would create a select committee to investigate the Administration's intent to go to war before congressional authorization, manipulation of pre-war intelligence, encouraging and countenancing torture, and retaliating against critics, and to make recommendations regarding grounds for possible impeachment.	
	H.Res.636	Conyers (D-MI)	Would censure Bush for failing to respond to requests for information concerning allegations that he and others in the Administration misled Congress and the American people regarding the decision to go to war in Iraq, misstated and manipulated intelligence information regarding the justification for the war, countenanced torture and cruel, inhuman, and degrading treatment of persons in Iraq, and permitted inappropriate retaliation against critics of the Administration, for failing to adequately account for certain misstatements they made regarding the war, and for failing to comply with Executive Order 12958.	
	H.Res.637	Conyers (D-MI)	Would censure Cheney for failing to respond to requests for information concerning allegations that he and others in the Administration misled Congress and the American people regarding the decision to go to war in Iraq, misstated and manipulated intelligence information regarding the justification for the war, countenanced torture and cruel, inhuman, and degrading treatment of persons in Iraq, and permitted inappropriate retaliation against critics of the Administration, for failing to adequately account for certain misstatements they made regarding the war.
